BOARDING POLICY

Thank you for choosing our boarding facility for your pet while you are away. We will do everything we can to be sure your pet is well cared for and comfortable in your absence. Please read the following information about our boarding policies. We would be happy to assist you with any questions you may have. These policies have been established for your pet's protection and safety.

______We require that your pet be current on vaccinations. Canines must have Rabies, Distemper/Parvo, and Bordetella. Felines must have Rabies and RCP. If vaccinations were administered elsewhere, we will need verification of the dates, vaccine type, and place of administration. If your pet's vaccinations are not current, they must be brought up to date prior to boarding.

_____We also require your pet be free of external parasites. If your pet has parasites (fleas, ticks, etc.), measures will be taken to treat them appropriately. This may include an oral Capstar to kill current fleas or a dewormer if intestinal parasites are seen in fecal material. The cost will be reflected on your bill when you pick your animal up at the end of its stay with us.

_____Should your animal become ill while staying with us, every attempt will be made to contact you first. In the event an emergency arises, and we are unable to reach you, we reserve the right to take every reasonable measure to treat your pet appropriately in your absence.

______If you are boarding more than one pet with us, we do not recommend that they stay in the same run or cage. While they may get along well at home, some animals do not get along well in a confined environment. If you do wish your pets board together, please understand the risk of injury and any treatment costs will be the responsibility of the owner.

I have more than one DOG/CAT (please circle) boarding and I WOULD/WOULD NOT (please circle) like them boarded in the same cage/run.

We strive to maintain a comfortable and low stress boarding experience for your pet. Sometimes, despite every measure, dogs and cats will be stressed while boarding and develop GI upset (vomiting, diarrhea, decreased appetite). Often times these patients feel better if we start them on some anti-diarrheal, anti-nausea, or anti-anxiety medications (anxiety reducing supplements).

I would like a Cityview Animal Hospital Doctor to treat my pet as needed for GI upset (vomiting, diarrhea, decreased appetite) and anxiety (anxiety reducing supplements) if the need arises. Owner is responsible for costs of medications.

OR

I would like to be contacted for permission to treat GI upset and anxiety should the need arise. I understand that if I cannot be reached and there is concern for the safety and well-being of my pet, treatment will be initiated.

There is a \$2.25 medication fee charged each time we administer medications to your pet, whether you bring the medication from home or we prescribe the medication in clinic.
